**League of Women Voters to Host Conference Call with Experts on
2014 Proposed Constitutional Amendments
Wednesday, September 24, 11:00 AM (EDT)**

Tallahassee, Fla -- In a bid to help Florida voters be better prepared prior to voting in this November's election, the League of Women Voters of Florida is hosting a conference call for members of the media tomorrow at 11:00 AM (EDT) to provide information from a panel of experts on the proposed constitutional amendments and release the League's positions on the amendments.

"When it comes to ballot amendments, most voters are looking for help and are eager to be better informed," says League of Women Voters of Florida President Deirdre Macnab. "We strive to help voters realize the importance and impact amendments can have on the way our state is governed, and our quality of life, for decades to come."

During the media call, a panel of experts will discuss both Amendments 1 and 3. This is an opportunity to speak with state experts about these issues and ask questions. Details about the call are given below.

The League, which is nonpartisan and has never supported a candidate or political party during its 94-year history, extensively studied the pros and cons of each amendment and is planning a campaign to reach voters in the weeks to come.

"While we urge voters to study the pros and cons in detail, many voters do ask the League where we stand on these decisions. Now is the time for us to get the information out to the public so that when voters go to the polls they are informed about issues that can change Florida forever," Macnab concluded.
